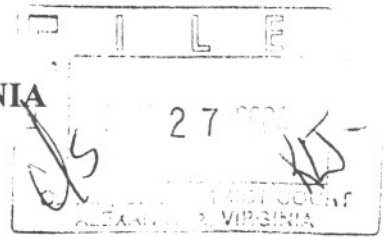

**AGREED ORDER**


