ORDER

Upon consideration of respondent's petition for rehearing and/or clarification, the intervenor American Petroleum Institute's petition for rehearing, and the responses thereto, it is

ORDERED that the issuance of the court's mandate be stayed pending respondent's reconsideration of its Section 18(a)(2)(G) and 18(a)(3) analysis. In reconsidering its analysis, respondent is advised that the relief granted in the opinion issued April 17, 2009, relates only to Alaska, specifically leasing in Chukchi, Beaufort and the Bering Seas.

Respondent is directed to file status reports within 60 days of the date of this order, and at 60-day intervals thereafter. Respondent is to notify the court promptly upon completion of its analysis. The parties are directed to file motions to govern future proceedings within 30 days of the date of completion of the analysis.
