As we previously stated in our May 23, 2001 email to you, BEA supports the thrust of the proposed guidelines. Nonetheless, there is one point that needs to be clarified; namely the party responsible for data quality. As mentioned in our previous email, data quality responsibilities at BEA are primarily under the purview of Chief Statistician and not the Chief Information Officer. By directing the information technology efforts of agencies, CIOs clearly play a role in ensuring data quality. The

Guidelines for Ensuring and Maximizing the Quality, Objectivity, Utility, and Integrity of Information Disseminated by Federal Agencies"on the above

guidelines, however, appear to give CIOs the ultimate responsibility for data quality. At BEA, the ultimate responsibility for data quality resides
